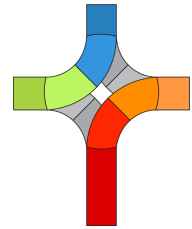


ACTIVITIES AT CONCORD: PROTOCOLS AND PROCEDURES

EFFECTIVE MONDAY, March 7, 2022



In light of the status of New Castle County as having a LOW community level for the virus, and the CDC protocols and Delaware state guidelines for that status, on March 1 session approved the following protocols for activities in our buildings:

- **MASK WEARING** is now optional in the building, though you may choose to mask at any time. People with symptoms, a positive test, or exposure to someone with COVID-19 should stay home.
- **WE RECOGNIZE** that some are nervous about these changes and will continue to wear masks, and we support those who make that decision. Those who have certain health conditions or who are unvaccinated are encouraged to wear masks. - **SOCIAL DISTANCING** in worship is optional but ENCOURAGED for the near future as we monitor circumstances during this time of transition.
- **FOOD & BEVERAGE** may be served during group events if desired. After-worship fellowship (aka "Concord Connects") will not resume yet; our Worship & Music and Mission & Congregational Life committees will discuss this and determine when it seems like the right time to return to this practice.
- **A RECORD OF THOSE ATTENDING WORSHIP**, previously compiled for use in contact tracing, will no longer be kept.
